



RIGHTS RESPECTING SCHOOLS

Bronze hts Committed

As a Bronze Rights Respecting School we are committed in upholding all rights of all children, all of the time.

Article 20

Article 20 of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) states that every child who cannot be looked after by their own family has the right to be looked after properly by people who respect the child's religion, culture, language and other aspects of their life 123. The government must provide the child with special protection and assistance, including making sure the child is provided with alternative care that is continuous and respects the child's culture, language and religions.

The rights of the child are enshrined in the "United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child," which was adopted by the United Nations in 1989. The UK signed the convention on 19 April 1990, ratified it on 16 December 1991 and it came into force on 15 January 1992. There are 54 articles.
